**Subject: OPD patients limit and IPD admissions - reg.**

i)- This is in Pursuance of MOM F. No. A- 17001/10/2016/AIIA/OPD/9095 Dated 12.02.2022. In view of Increasing demand by Patients and decrease in number of Covid -19 Case, it has been decided daily that OPD limit of Patients can be Increased to 600 with immediate effect till further orders.

It is to be ensured that all should adhere to Covid appropriate and Ayurveda appropriate behavior in Hospital premises.

ii)- Reinitiating IPD Admissions for Non- Covid Patients will also be continued subject to Following Conditions:

- The Patients with Flu like symptoms/ may be put in isolation room and tested for Covid – 19 (RTPCR) before they can be accommodated in general/ main ward.
- RTPCR may be advised before any procedure as recommended by consulting Physician.

Covid appropriate behavior \* and Ayurveda appropriate behavior\*\* in Hospital premises.

\*Covid Appropriate behavior: -

- Mask
- Social Distancing
- Frequent hand washing

\*\*Ayurveda appropriate: -

- Gargle & steam inhalation
- Ayush Kwath/or Herbal decoction intake
- Samsahavani vati/Giloy vati intake
- Nasal drops – 2 drops of Anu Tail in each nostril
- Use of Chyawanprash & or any Rasayan intake as immunity booster
