Format of Internal assessment:

Theory: -

- 2. Paper II: Written examination, concerned subject Max. 50 marks, 2-hour duration.

Practical: -

- 1. Paper I: Oral examination, Research Methodology and Biostatistics 50 marks (2-day exam)
- 2. Paper II: Oral examination, concerned subject 50 marks, (2-day exam)

Note: Paper setting team will prepare the question bank and submit it to the dean office

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This institute is academically affiliated with the University of Delhi, which guides and directs the smooth operation of classes in accordance with NCISM instructions and guidelines (CCIM PREVIOUSLY). Courses, course contents, course duration, learning evaluation, and so on are all policy issues that this institute adheres to in full. There is no provision of internal assessment in MD course and Ph.D. We are doing internal assessment to improve teaching and learning process. As per policy decision, there is a provision for internal assessment in the MD and Ph.D. courses. We are conducting internal assessments in order to improve the teaching and learning process. Continuous internal assessment is carried out in the month of May/June in the form of written tests, practical/viva-voce, and evaluation of research work. Internal assessment dates are set in the academic calendar. It is the department's responsibility to prepare question paper sets for all courses in accordance with the academic calendar. The departmental teachers score the answer sheets after they have been labelled. The question papers include questions from the entire syllabus covered during that time period. To keep the variety of questions, all types of questions, such as MCQs, Short and Long, are included in the question paper. Written examination of Research Methodology and Biostatistics & oral examination of the same is also conducted. Many objective structured clinical or practical examination tools have been developed by our faculty members, and they are an important part of the majority of clinical research work. The institute's continuous internal assessment evaluation system is adaptable and student-cantered. There is a special feedback system in place to collect reviews and suggestions from stakeholders. Following each internal assessment test, feedback forms from students are collected at random. Students are encouraged to provide feedback on any suggested changes to the internal evaluation system in order to make it more fruitful and result oriented. A committee of feedback evaluation Program critically analyses student feedback for corrective measures in the internal evaluation system, if necessary. The committee's decision is being implemented for the next evaluation test, and so on. This process is becoming increasingly successful. Due to the Covid protocol, written examinations were not encouraged during the Covid outbreak. As a result, an innovative method of evaluation was adopted, which included competency-based assessment, workplace-based assessment, and overall performance of the student in classes and in department. After identifying slow and fast learners, it is the department's collective responsibility to improve the performance of slow learners in the future.
