Following is a Brief Report:

As per the request received from Naina Devi Seva Samiti Samsthan, Faridabad, to organize a free medical camp for the residents of Sector 29, Faridabad, a team of consultants and attendants conducted the camp on 23th June, 2019. Medicines for free dispensing were procured from the Pharmacy

The team departed from AIIA campus at 08:45 am and reached the camp site i.e. Community Hall Sector 29 Faridabad, by 09:10 am. The camp was attended by mostly middle aged and elderly people. In all 249 patients registered for the camp and availed Ayurvedic consultation for various ailments. Out of these 140 were males, 96 were females and 13 were children. Most of the patients were from upper and upper middle socio-economic class and literate.


