
PHARMACOVIGILANCE DETAILS

 - A website for "Pharmacovigilance Program for ASU & H Drugs" is functional since July 2019. It can be accessed at www.ayushsuraksha.com
 In addition to the information of the program, the website has provisions for online submission of Suspected ADR Reports and Reporting of Objectionable Advertisements.
- Modes of ADR Reporting: Suspected ADR reporting form was developed in consultation with IPC, Ghaziabad and the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi. The form was finalized by the Ministry in December 2018.
