2. The terms and conditions of deputation of Shri Roshan Jaggi, Joint Secretary Ministry of AYUSH and Dr. Galib, Associate Professor, All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) are given as under:-

a. **Period of Deputation:** The period of deputation to Finland and Estonia, will be for 03 day i.e. 12<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 (excluding journey period).

b. **Passage:**

(i) The Officials will be travelling as per their entitled class (i.e. **Business Class** for Shri Roshan Jaggi, Jt. Secretary and **Economy Class** for Dr. Galib, Associate Professor) in terms of Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) O.M. 2. Name of faculties from AIIA and IITD mentioned against the sanctioned research projects at Annexure-A are the Principal Investigators concerned project.
3. In accordance with approval of Standing Finance Committee (SFC) of the Institute and as per the terms and conditions mentioned in MoUs with IITD for this purpose, payment of AIIA contribution towards these research projects will be made from the sanctioned budget of AIIA for the Financial Year 2020-21 and 2021-22 as per the details mentioned in the list enclosed at Annexure-A.
