2. If any document/Certificate furnished in a language other than Hindi or English, a transcript in Hindi/English of the same duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or Notary is to be submitted.
3. The date for determining the age and qualification will be the closing date prescribed for receipt of application.
4. Institute reserves the right to make any amendment, cancellation, and changes in this advertisement in whole or as per part without assigning any reason thereof.
