Exam Notice

With reference to Recruitment Advertisement No. AIIA/Rectt./07/2023, AIIA/Rectt./01/2022, AIIA/Rectt./03/2022 and AIIA/Rectt./02/2023 published to invite applications for the post of **Staff Nurse** at the All India Institute of Ayurveda, New Delhi and Goa, the **Offline OMR-based Written Test** is scheduled to be held on **27.04.2025 (Sunday)** from **11:00 AM to 01:00 PM** at various centers in **Delhi NCR only**.

1. Admit Card Instructions:

- a) Admit Cards for candidates who applied under Advertisement No. AIIA/Rectt./07/2023 can be downloaded from https://aiiarecruitment.org from 21.04.2025.
- b) For candidates who applied under Advertisement Nos. AIIA/Rectt./01/2022, AIIA/Rectt./03/2022 and AIIA/Rectt./02/2023. Admit Cards will be provided only through email. Candidates are advised to check their email regularly. Candidates under these advertisements may also collect their Admit Cards from Administration Section, AIIA New Delhi up to 25.04.2025, if they have not received them by email.

2. Additional Instructions:

- a) The Written Test will consist of 100 multiple-choice questions, each carrying one mark.
 - a. One mark will be awarded for each correct answer.
 - b. ¼ mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.
- b) Duration of the Written Test: 120 minutes.
- c) Reporting time for the Written Test: 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- d) Candidates must bring a valid **Original Photo ID proof issued by a government organization** to the examination center along with their admit card.
- e) Complaints regarding ambiguous questions, if any, must be submitted to the **Examination Centre Superintendent within one hour** after the test. No complaints will be entertained after that. The decision of the competent authority will be final.
- f) Only a black or blue transparent ballpoint pen will be allowed in the exam hall.
- g) **Books, notes, bags, mobile phones, calculators**, or **any electronic devices** are strictly prohibited inside the exam center. There will be **no facility for safe-keeping**, and any loss will be the sole responsibility of the candidate.
- h) Candidates must fill in their **roll number clearly** in the space provided on the OMR sheet.
- i) Do not write or mark anything on the question booklet, **except on the last blank page** provided for rough work.
- j) Candidates are provisionally admitted for the Written Test based on the information filled in their application form. Only those fulfilling the essential eligibility criteria will be considered for the final merit list. Candidates are advised to ensure their eligibility in advance.
- k) Candidates will be required to submit **self-attested copies** of all relevant documents along with originals for verification when asked. Any false or incomplete information will result in the **cancellation of candidature at any stage** of the recruitment process.
